THE search is on for the 2019 KZN Young Farmer of the Year.

Candidates must be 40 years or younger on the day on 31 July.

The farmer is judged on his/her management philosophy, as well as the technical manner in which it is executed.

The size of the farming enterprise is not crucial and game/livestock farmers, grain/fruit/wine farmers or mixed farmers have the same chance of winning.

Candidates may farm on their own farms or in partnership with others.

In the case of a partnership, the candidate must have specific allocated responsibilities and decision-making authority.

The candidate must be involved in the application of management functions (planning, implementation and control) in all fields, even though the candidate may only be involved in some of the farm's enterprises.
