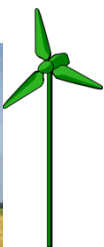

Information on Small Scale Generation



Roof Top Photovoltaic (PV), Wind and other small scale Customer owned generation must be done in a manner that is safe. Before any generator is connected to the grid, permission from the Network Service Provider is required to ensure safety and legal compliance to the Occupational Health and Safety Act of 1993

In order to grant access to the grid for all applications, Eskom requires the following high level process to be followed.

The process to follow is:

1. Consult the Eskom website and determine if the type of installation is allowed by Eskom. If allowed, complete the Eskom application form.
2. Register with NERSA after Eskom has quoted for the grid connection requirements including but not limited to, the installation of new meters.
3. Completion of work quoted for together with new contracts and agreements after registration.
4. Changes in the Eskom billing system for the account.

Failure to follow the process constitutes a statutory offence and Eskom will consider the entire installation to be illegal and request that the generator be disconnected until the process is completed. Failure to comply will result in tamper fee charges together with the disconnection of the main supply. Eskom will also raise charges to recover lost revenue.
