Simon D'Aubrey, Kwanalu's Young Farmer of the Year for 2019, is the third generation to farm on Arcadia Estate at Eshowe. They farm with sugar cane, wood, lemons and avocados.

Arcadia Estates harvests about 20,000 tons of sugar per year and also has 60 ha of wattle and eucalyptus trees - mainly for pulp for papermaking. Simon emphasizes the conservation of land for future generations and plans his farming methods around the area. He says you should treat your land with compassion, respect your workers and always be ready for change.
