YOUNG farmers are being encouraged to enter the Agri SA National Young Farmer of the Year competition.

The Toyota-sponsored competition is held annually.

Farmers of national choice are the winners of provincial competitions. The KwaZulu-Natal Agricultural Union (Kwanalu) has opened this year's intervention. An ambassador for under-40s to participate.

Kwanalu chief executive officer Sandy La Marque said: "The competition highlights the skills and ambition needed to become an entrepreneur. We know we are blessed with the kind of top farmers in our province but this competition is not just about how much the farmer produces and how good his farm is. He is focused on how he has managed the business and the farming methods he uses and many other considerations."

Disqualified by smallholder farmers under the age of 40 who may be farm owners or shareholders on the farm, are men and women and are full members of a farmers' union in their provinces.

The judges visit the farms to see how they are treated, the way things are done. They look at everything and the way money is spent, the budget, the way money is invested, the way disease is handled, farming, cultivating and more. It looks at the way workers are treated, the ideas for land reform, the transformation of the industry and how society is involved.
